

Definition of Pre-conditions and Entry Requirements

PRE-CONDITION AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- There is **a requirement** for a list of Pre-conditions and Entry Requirements for Certification Candidates (ie. pre-reviewed literature/pre-qualification achieved).
- The list may include the **average workload** (learning units/hours) **needed** for admission.

IMPORTANT FEATURES

- Pre-conditions and Entry Requirements should be appropriate to the certified competence and intended NQF.
- They should be **agreed with the Steering Board** for the Single Certification Programme.
- They **should not be** overly difficult, time-consuming or expensive.
- They **are dependent on the competencies** to be certified.

WHAT TO BE AWARE OF

- The **aim** of both is to **maintain quality standards and trustworthiness** in the Certification.
- If there is a requirement for a certain pre-qualification/training programme, that **VET provider would need to be approved** as a training institute.
- This offer must also **transfer to all other VET providers** who wish to prepare learners for the certification process.
