



The MC GREEN project aims to apply the internationally recognised ISO 17024 standard to ensure quality assurance in micro-credentials within European vocational education. Based on an analysis of ISO requirements and current VET practices, two innovative micro-credential programmes in the green economy will be tested.

## WHAT?

**Micro-credentials** are short, focused certificates that prove specific skills. In VET, they help meet job market needs.

**ISO 17024** is a global standard for certifying individuals, ensuring consistent quality.

The **MC GREEN project** promotes ISO 17024 for VET micro-credentials and offers free training materials.

## WHY?

Micro-credentials **boost learning and employability**, but their value depends on trust: employers and institutions must be able to trust the validated skills.

In higher education, **quality assurance** systems exist, but VET lacks a unified, recognised approach.

ISO 17024 offers a clear, **internationally accepted standard** to build credibility and ensure consistent quality.

## HOW?

Courses must be designed to **meet ISO requirements** from the start: quality must follow the standard.

The MC GREEN project uses **ISO 17024 as the basis for quality assurance** in VET micro-credentials.

The **MC GREEN training package** helps providers align their courses with ISO 17024 to ensure trust and recognition.



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
