## CERTIFICATION BODIES

Cooperation with a registered Certification Body is essential for applying IS017024.

**IFA Cert Search** is a platform to find Accreditation and Certification bodies worldwide.

VET providers may search for Certification Bodies **outside of their own country**.

## CERTIFICATION \_\_\_SCHEME \_\_\_

**Developing** a Certification Scheme **must be done together** with the Certification Body.

A Certification Scheme is the **answer** to new challenges on the market that require new **knowledge**, skills and competencies.

A Certification Scheme is **not** a Training Programme.

The Certification Body provides the structure/format for the scheme.

## STEERING BOARD FOR CERTIFICATION SCHEME

There is an **obligatory requirement** for a Steering Board for the single Certification Scheme (consisting of 3–5 people).

It is made up of experts and stakeholders representing the market, sector or industry.

They are responsible for **approving**, **monitoring** and **evaluating** the scheme.

They provide **impartiality** as part of the certification process.
